Twelve slides, each with the sentences you can say.

Independent affiliate material. Wyld Notes is a brand of Young Living. Wienen Media is an affiliate in the Wyld Notes Affiliate Program; this hub is not operated by Wyld Notes.

SLIDE 1

WYLD NOTES IS COMING TO EUROPE

- Perfume from Young Living, developed with a French fragrance house
- According to the brand, 100% natural ingredients, essential oils from Young Living's own farms
- From 19 September 2026 with delivery to Europe

It is not an oil and not a supplement. It is a perfume, and that is exactly what makes it easy to explain.

SLIDE 2

WHY IT EXISTS

- Almost every woman wears perfume; oils need explaining, perfume does not
- Wyld Notes is the way in for people who are not ready for oils yet
- In the US, many inactive Brand Partners got back in touch because of it

Wyld Notes said it in the webinar itself: it was never only about perfume, but about new people in the conversation.

SLIDE 3

THE FOUR SCENTS

- White Lie: bright, powdery, dry
- Sweet Decadence: sweet, but grounded
- Smokey Ember: forest, resin, lemon
- Black Book: spice, frankincense, tonka

Four directions, by the official pyramids.
Nobody needs to memorise more than that.

SLIDE 4

THE ALCOHOL

- Almost every perfume is mostly alcohol
- Denatured alcohol is the usual: an additive makes it undrinkable, and which one is not stated
- Wyld Notes states that it uses undenatured organic sugar-cane alcohol, three to four times the price

This is the story that sticks, and it is on every label: Alcohol denat., or simply Alcohol.

SLIDE 5

THE WORD NATURAL AND THE STANDARD

- Anyone can put natural on a label
- ISO 9235: obtained by physical means only, not chemically altered afterwards
- Wyld Notes states that it uses only natural materials that meet this standard

A word against a yardstick. That explains in one sentence why this is different.

SLIDE 6

THE FRAGRANCE HOUSE AND LONGEVITY

- 150-year-old family house in France, fifth generation, perfumer with 50 years of experience
- Every batch is readjusted, because every harvest smells different
- Longevity according to the maker: at least four to six hours

That answers the most common objection: natural perfume does not last. This is exactly what took the longest to get right.

SLIDE 7

HOW THE PROGRAMME WORKS

- Your link: wyldnotes.com/?ref=YourName, 30-day attribution
- 25% commission on every order, repeat orders included, paid weekly via PayPal
- 100% of the volume counts in your Young Living business according to the programme description, customer on your frontline
- No minimum purchase, no Young Living account required; 25% off your own purchases; Discovery Sets: commission yes, Young Living commission no

Not a business next to yours. A way into yours.

SLIDE 8

WHAT IS PROHIBITED

- Paid advertising of any kind
- Wyld Notes in your profile name or URL
- Voucher sites and reveal-the-code tricks
- Health claims and scare tactics

Four things that cost you the account. All four are easy to avoid.

SLIDE 9

EUROPE IS STRICTER

- Labelling: “Ad”, visible
- No customer data from the back office in your own lists without consent
- No prices, shipping or return details from us; link instead

What is common in the US is partly prohibited here. That is why these guardrails exist.

SLIDE 10

THE NEXT 21 DAYS

- Now: build a waiting list with one question
- T-7: one email, T-1: one message
- Launch day: link, code, four scents
- After that: follow up, collect questions, scent tasting evening

One day, one action, one ready-made text. The plan is in the hub.

SLIDE 11

THE SCENT TASTING EVENING

- Six to ten guests, four scents, scent strips, coffee beans
- Smell from bright to dark, one question after each scent
- Link and code at the end, not before

Whoever smells it, gets it. The evening replaces every argument.

SLIDE 12

YOUR FIRST 48 HOURS

- Get your link and code, name your profiles by the rules
- Read the hardest questions once
- Ask five people the waiting-list question

Three things today, and you are further along than most.
